The *terroir* of Cache Creek Vineyards provides the perfect growing conditions to create a delicious, true-to-varietal Syrah. With only one acre of Syrah planted, we only produce a limited amount of this classic French Rhône varietal. Our Syrah exhibits a luscious array of flavors with just the right amount of spice, while also offering a soft, rich mouthfeel and finish. Enjoyable now, this wine will continue to evolve and develop with additional bottle aging for several more years.

TASTING NOTES

Seductive aromas and flavors of creamy mocha and brown spice-laced dark fruit fill your senses. The plush mouthfeel reveals ripe boysenberry and plum layered with traces of leather, coffee, cardamom, and molasses. A seamlessly integrated oak and tannin structure provides support and ageability to the wine. In the long finish, the opulent flavors expand across the palate and linger on.

This is the perfect wine to grab to pair with smoky barbecued ribs and a side of broccoli slaw, or coffee-rubbed roast chicken served with grilled eggplant and smashed potatoes.
