WINEMAKER NOTES

The Sweet Rosé is only slightly sweet when compared to our dry Rosé. Like the dry Rosé, it's made from pure "free run" juice that was drawn off the skins after a bit longer time than the "dry" version. The small amount of extra time on the skins brings out more Cabernet flavors and extra richness in the finish. The juice is then cold fermented for several weeks to capture the fresh berry like aromas and flavors from the Cabernet. The resulting wine is rich with a lingering, almost sweet finish.

TASTING NOTES

A brilliant magenta hue and delicious aromas of Rainier cherry and fresh strawberry create an ideal foyer for this scrumptious Rosé. The palate presents a rich blend of ripe cherry and vine-ripened strawberry and raspberry balanced with bright acidity that adds a lively zing. A touch of lime zest appears as the wine lingers in the finish.
