Sparkling WINES

BOTTLE / CASE

2019 Celebration Rosé \$44/\$528
\$11/glass

Enticing aromatics fill the nose with a blend of raspberry, strawberry and cherry, while traces of honey and acacia add an exotic element. Persistent bubbles burst on the palate, providing a refreshing, crisp entry for this delicious sparkler. A mix of fresh black raspberry, dark cherry, plum and blackberry mingle with hints of minerality. Lively from the first taste until the slightly spicy long finish, Celebration Rosé leaves you longing for the next sip.

2019 Celebration Cuvée Blanc de Blanc . \$42/\$504
\$11/glass

Subtle yet enticing aromatics of Meyer lemon, slivered roasted almonds, fresh baked bread and white floral fill the nose. A refreshing entry quickly exposes a rich texture as the flavors are slowly revealed. Gentle traces of blood orange and Asian pear mingle with hints of brioche and ginger. Just as this magic liquid hits mid-palate, a creamy caramel essence—reminiscent of crème brûlée with the perfect crust on top—appears. Enduring bubbles fill the palate and linger into the persistent finish, giving the perfect sipping experience from beginning to end.

White WINES

BOTTLE / CASE

2023 Sauvignon Blanc \$26/\$312
\$8/glass

Enticing aromatics fill the nose with lemon blossoms and tropical fruit, along with subtle a mix of citrus and pineapple. The creamy entry encompasses the palate with delicious flavors of honeysuckle, Pomelo, white peach, honeydew and lime zest. A touch of salinity enhances the mouthwatering aspect of this refreshing wine. Beautifully balanced bright flavors set against a velvety texture create an easy sipping wine that disappears quickly from your glass.

2021 Reserve Sauvignon Blanc \$36/\$432
\$10/glass

The aromas of freshly zested lemon mingle with hints of white floral, guava and oak, luring you to sip. A silky mouthfeel reveals flavors of key lime pie and juicy pomelo. Balanced acidity and traces of oak provide a subtle structure, while a touch of limestone minerality and brown autumn spices round out the wine as it lingers on the palate.

2023 Chardonnay \$26/\$312
\$8/glass

Enchanting aromas of white peach mingle with traces of lime zest, Meyer lemon and white floral. The smooth rounded entry offers bright, mouthwatering acidity by mid-palate that carries through into a lingering finish. A slightly creamy texture balances the acidity as it bathes captivating flavors of fresh-squeezed lime, Braeburn apple, pear, pineapple and lemon. Even with its layers of complexity, this is an easy sipping Chardonnay.

White WINES (CONTINUED)

2021 Reserve Chardonnay \$36/\$432
\$10/glass

Tempting aromas of perfectly ripe pear hit the nose first, with creamy lemon curd and tropical fruit joining in. A silky rich texture exposes layers of crème caramel laced with lychee, lemon zest and a hint of cinnamon that coat the palate and then linger on. The perfect amount of gentle acidity and just a kiss of oak balance the velvety mouthfeel and luscious fruit while adding complexity and depth.

Rosé OF CABERNET SAUVIGNON

2021 Rosé \$22/\$264
\$7/glass

Enchanting aromas offer sweet ripe cherry and dark plum laced with a creamy essence. The palate follows suit with delicious flavors of wild blackberry and black plum bathed in balanced mouthwatering acidity. Hints of fresh strawberry pie appear as the wine persists into a long finish.

2021 Sweet Rosé \$22/\$264
\$7/glass

Enticing aromatics of freshly sliced watermelon and Queen Anne cherry fuse with hints of white floral and savory herbs. The juicy entry exposes luscious watermelon and ripe red cherry bathed in a creamy, round texture. The rich flavors are nicely balanced with gentle acidity, adding to the wine’s depth.

Sweet WHITE BLEND

2021 Sunset on the Vine \$22/\$264
\$7/glass

Seductive, perfumey aromatics of ripe peach and apricot fuse with hints of tropical fruit. The velvety entry reveals vivid fruit flavors wrapped in a rich texture. A blend of stone fruit—white peach, nectarine and apricot—along with green apple and pineapple fill the palate with luscious flavors. Traces of honeysuckle and lime zest join in at the long, smooth finish. So refreshingly delicious, you’ll always want to have a chilled bottle available.

Red WINES

2020 Syrah \$32/\$384
\$9/glass

A positively seductive nose offers dark berries and red fruit woven with hints of leather and juniper berry. With the first sip, the palate is quickly immersed in a fusion of intense ripe blackberry, blueberry, espresso and dark chocolate laced with traces of well-worn leather found in the nose. The richness is balanced with gentle tannins and integrated oak that frame the luscious flavors. As the wine coalesces in the finish, the delicious essence lingers.

2020 Bugle Call \$40/480
\$11/glass

Layers of rich aromatics offer dark cherry, plum and blackberry with hints of spice and vanillin oak. The spiciness found on the nose weaves through the palate, along with dark ripe fruit — boysenberry, Santa Rosa plum and Bing cherry. The structure stays in the background, providing a mouthwatering acidity and notes of oak. A touch of leather and an appealing earthiness appear as the flavors coalesce in the finish.

2019 Malbec *Wine Club Only Wine* \$40/\$480
\$11/glass

Enticing aromatics of ripe plum and fresh berries fill the nose, along with traces of forest floor and herbs de Provence. With the first sip, focused flavors burst onto the palate showcasing juicy blackberry, dark cherry, black raspberry and a hint of blueberry that remain into the long finish. Layers of creamy mocha, vanilla bean and silken dark chocolate join the delicious berry essence and slightly spicy cedar texture. The combination of the rich flavors and acidity in the structure lends a mouth-watering quality to the wine, leading you back for another sip.

Red WINES (CONTINUED)

BOTTLE / CASE

2020 Cabernet Sauvignon \$40/\$480
\$11/glass

Hints of cocoa and sagebrush mingle with subtle aromas of boysenberry and black raspberry, creating an inviting entry into this delicious wine. The smooth palate offers deep flavors of muted cherry, brambly blackberry, chocolate and mocha oak. Traces of earth and dried fine herbs add a savory quality just as juicy berry notes appear near the finish and linger. The restrained structure gently frames the wine, enhancing without deterring from this approachable Cabernet’s appeal.

2020 Majestic Elk \$58/\$696
\$14/glass

The nose offers layers of tempting aromas of rich cassis and brambly blackberry woven with hints of spicy cedar, tobacco and toasty oak. From the first sip, the palate is filled with mouthwatering yet plush flavors — Bing cherry, boysenberry, black raspberry, red currant and dark plum — laced with a lovely mineral saline essence. Traces of leather and loamy earth add interest while integrated mocha-tinged oak and bright acidity lend balance and depth. As the flavors fuse and linger, you start to long for the next sip.

2020 Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon \$60/\$720
\$15/glass

Even the nose conveys the wine’s elegance, with deep aromas of black cherry and boysenberry laced with spicy cedar along with a touch of violet floral and oak notes. The silken smooth entry reveals a lively palate of red currant, cassis, dark cherry, blackberry and forest floor. Mid-palate, traces of mocha, caramel and minerality enhance the flavors while adding an element of depth. Supple tannins and seamlessly integrated oak are woven with a backbone of gentle acidity, the perfect framework for this delicious, sophisticated Cabernet.

2020 Wapiti Red \$40/\$480
\$11/glass

A captivating nose offers concentrated blackberry laced with the spicy aromatics of forest floor, enticing you to linger and enjoy the beautiful aromas. The plush entry quickly shares a burst of bright flavors—boysenberry, red cherry and huckleberry. Mocha and a subtle herbal essence appear mid-palate, as does the gentle oak and supple tannin structure, balancing the luscious layers. A wine with finesse and depth that will have you longing for more.

2018 Petit Verdot \$35/\$420
\$10/glass

Subtle aromas of loamy earth and a rich mineral essence join an intense blend of dark ripe berries that fills the nose. A smooth entry reveals layers of black cherry, boysenberry and cassis wrapped with traces of coffee, violet, chocolate, licorice and juniper. Buoyant acidity bathes the palate while vanillin oak gently supports, but never overpowers, the dense, luscious lingering flavors.

2020 Petite Sirah \$38/\$456
\$10/glass

Enticing aromatics fill the nose with an intense berry essence laced with deep oak notes, reminiscent of a cellar at the height of harvest. The rounded entry exposures a rich mix of dark berries laced with cedary oak. Traces of ripe cherry, mocha and dark chocolate appear as the wine opens, adding layers of complexity and depth. Delicious now, this is a wine that could age for a decade or more.

Dessert WINE

2017 Elk in Velvet (375ml) \$38/\$456 (375ml)
\$70/\$840 (750ml)

Sweet seductive aromas of luscious caramel-laced boysenberry preserves fill the nose. Savor the wine’s richness starting with its silken entry and into a delicious blackberry cobbler and ripe Bing cherry core. Decadent toffee notes add depth, while creamy chocolate that appears in the finish gives this delightful wine its perfect ending.
